December 2008 and January 2009 classifications

In December 2008 the Office classified two games:

- *Killzone 2* - R16 Graphic violence and offensive language
- *50 Cent: Blood On The Sand* - R18 Violence and offensive language

In January 2009 the Office classified seven games:

- *The Royal Marines Commando* - R16 Violence
- *Crash Commando* - R13 Violence
- *F.E.A.R. 2 Project Origin (aka First Encounter Assault Recon: Project Origin)*
- R18 Violence and horror
- *Grand Theft Auto: Chinatown Wars (aka GTA Chinatown Wars)* - R16
Offensive language, violence and other content that may offend
- *The Godfather II (aka The Godfather 2)* - R18 Violence, sexual themes and
offensive language
- *Wanted: Weapons of Fate* - R16 Violence and offensive language
- *Watchmen: The End is Nigh* - R18 Violence and offensive language
