<i>L.A. Noire</i>	R16 Contains violence, offensive language and content that may disturb	08/04/2011
<i>Red Faction: Armageddon</i>	R16 Contains violence	15/04/2011
<i>The Official Xbox 360 Magazine Issue 67: Cover Disc</i>	R18 Contains violence and offensive language	18/04/2011

## The 'M' classification label

We've had a few calls lately from stores and customers confused about the meaning of the M classification label.

The M classification on a game means while it is recommended for mature audiences 16 and over, legally anyone can purchase or rent it.
